Courses combine the study of language structures with the development of oral and written expression and the knowledge of Italian culture.

Classes are held once a week and last 90 minutes. There are fourteen classes in a course. The short courses are held every other week. There are seven classes in a short course.

Kindly note there shall not be any classes from 20 to 23 February, and on 10 April.

Italian is the language of instruction but, if necessary, Finnish or English are also used.
